IDENTIFY YOUR PROPERTY

This property record is a place to record your valuables and any identifying serial numbers and marks, in case your home is burglarized.



When properly filled out, this record will help:

- determine the extent of your losses for insurance purposes.
- aid police in apprehending the thief.

Prosecution of the criminals frequently depends upon positive identification.

Mark your valuable property with your drivers license number and apply a small identification decal to each item. Then complete this record by listing each marked item. Include the serial numbers and any identifying marks that would help in the recovery of stolen property.

Be sure to mark and record all components in your computer and stereo systems. These are items frequently taken. Credit cards should also be listed with the account number. If your credit cards are stolen, report the theft immediately to the issuing company.

Contact your local police Crime Prevention unit for assistance, or availability of a Block/ Neighbourhood Watch program that may be in your community.
