There is an increase in theft of auto in the uptown area. In particular, older model Hondas are popular with thieves, however any vehicle can be a target. These thefts are preventable.

The New Westminster Police request vehicle owners to take steps in preventing these thefts.

- Use immobilizers, steering wheel locks, alarms or vehicle tracking systems.

- Remove all items and leave nothing behind in your vehicle (this includes GPS, gym or work bags, clothing and spare change etc).
- Secure all doors and windows.
- Report all suspicious and criminal activity immediately whether it is emergency or non-emergency.
